




#### **Our Programs**

#### 1. Women Entrepreneurship Development

This is our flagship program because we believe that if a woman gets money in hands, then she would be able to take care of all family requirements e.g. Kids Education, Healthcare, Nutritional Food, Shelter etc. So we decided to empower women through our comprehensive Women Entrepreneurship Development Program.

This program was supported by MetLife GOSC at Noida & Jaipur. Under this program, we are developing Women Entrepreneurs in the villages by supporting women to start a small business of their own choice and in their own village. Currently, we are supporting 60 women from 43 villages of Noida and Jaipur districts. We provide seed funds up to Rs. 10,000 - 15,000 per woman, business mentoring, training, market research support, branding, business promotional activities, market linkages etc. Different types of businesses started by women are Tailoring, Beauty Parlor, General Store, Vegetable Shop, Tiffin Center, Garments Store, Handicrafts Making & Selling, Grocery Shop, Stationary Shops etc. and they all are earning a net profit amount ranging from Rs. 4,000 to Rs. 15,000 per month based on their business type, location and time that they are investing in their businesses.

#### **Location - Jaipur**

It was a new location for this project in 2019-20 but we had an advantage of having our Head Office at Jaipur so we were aware about the geography, culture and local requirements for this project. This project has been supported by MetLife GOSC at Noida so they extended this project for Jaipur location also.

Initially there were many challenges to enter into villages where people didn't think of entrepreneurship from their own home and they were not ready to trust us as newcomers because many frauds took place in these villages with other chit fund companies. People found it difficult to believe that someone is genuinely trying to help them, but the MetLife brand helped us gain trust easily.

We have decided to work within 5 km radius from the MetLife office in Mahindra SEZ, Jaipur. We have worked in 15 villages and found a list of more than 55 women who had shown interest

in this program to receive grants of Rs. 10,000 to Rs. 15,000 to start their own business of their choice.

We had a very transparent selection process where all the women had an equal chance of selection. They passed through a defined selection process in which we had multiple visits to their houses for family background verification, existing support system, interviews with family members along with women, final interview at partner's office etc. Only then we selected the women for seed funding.

#### **Location - Noida**

We initiated this program with MetLife Noida in 2018-19. That year, we helped 16 women to become entrepreneurs in the villages near Noida. Therefore, it was a comparatively easy ride for us because we already knew the counters of the location and we had 16 success stories from different villages.

In 2019-20, MetLife Noida extended this project to support 28 women from the villages to become entrepreneurs based on the successful pilot of the previous year. This year we had a wonderful experience by adding more women in our project and many of them showed figures of income which were above our expectations.

We are supporting women's businesses with different types of promotional activities at their home or nearby places. Each woman entrepreneur plays a major role to organize the event and mobilize local people for the activity. These activities are great events to promote women's businesses as they get connected with the local villagers and also talk about their businesses. It helps them in the long run to get more business. We have done a total of 42 business promotional activities in the year 2019-20. It was a huge success and it impacted many lives in

the villages. Our women also got confidence for handling such events and they are now known as village change leaders.

#### 2. Skill Development

In India, less than 10% people get skill training and only 2% get formal skill training compared to 80% plus in developed countries. India has a huge gap in skilling people or developing entrepreneurs and this gap is much wider for women living in rural areas.

Hence we encourage youth to get formal skill training which can make them employable. At our vocational training center we provide different skill training to youth based on the requirements of local industries and also provide employment opportunities to women at our own centers by providing them Data Entry Operator & Tailoring Production related assignments. We also organize campus interviews at our centers by inviting corporate institutions.

We have tied up with various Skill based Institutes, Universities & Corporates which are doing excellent job in the field of Skill Development and also providing 100% employment assistance. We work as Mobilizers for these skill institutions and we mobilize youth for various skill development programs run by these institutions. We promote skill centers that provide high quality training and placements and either these courses are free of cost or provided at a very affordable price.

#### 3. Women Leadership Development, Jaipur

In India, women are mostly dependent on their fathers, husbands, brothers or uncles for their financial & non-financial requirements. Women are also not exposed to various job opportunities. Hence we believe that we must put in our honest efforts to help in empowering women.

This program is designed with deep understanding of the areas and varying cultures, allowing us to transform the lives of girls through life skills training and attitudinal changes. In our quest to create a platform for girls to attain education, academic and practical life skills, exposure visits, break cultural notions, norms and explore opportunities; we envision a future marked with community participation and active interventions. We are developing women leaders with skills like self-respect, socio-economic growth opportunities, women health, financial literacy, Indian laws and leadership, skill development and scholarships for higher education.

We have around 60 girls who are studying in college or are passed out from college, who are a part of this project. Many activities happened this year at these centers. We had regular workshops, art activities, village awareness initiatives, medical camps, exposure visits and guest lectures at our centers. Following activities were organized in 2019-20 at the centers:

- 1. 6 Personality Development sessions: Self Awareness, Decision Making, Communication etc.
- 2. 5 sessions on Health topics: Reproduction system, Menstrual hygiene, Food habits etc.
- 3. 2 Days Learning tour organized to Delhi and visited various sites across NCR.
- 4. Exposure visit organized to a Hospital to learn about various activities of the Hospital.
- 5. Exposure visit organized to a Trade Fair to learn about various livelihood products.
- 6. Career Awareness workshop organized for girls to know about 100 career options.
- 7. Regular English speaking classes organized for all the girls.
- 8. Handicraft making workshops were organized for the girls.
- 9. Important days were celebrated e.g. Diwali, Teachers day, New year, 2 Oct etc.

- 10. 6 Self Help Groups were formed to engage the village women and develop saving habits.
- 11. Road shows & street play organized to create awareness about Child Marriage issue.



#### 4. Education

It is our mission to strengthen the education foundation of students at an early age so he / she will achieve their career goals as per their interest. In 2019-20, we started our 3 new centers (1 in Noida and 2 in Jaipur) where we started providing education classes for the school students.



We provide the following facilities at our center for their holistic development:

- o Strengthen Educational Foundation through regular Science, Maths, English classes
- Computer classes for all the students
- Special classes for school drop-outs or non-school going students
- Scholarships for higher education of underprivileged meritorious students
- o Extracurricular activities e.g. Sports, Yoga, Dance, GK Quiz, Art, Panting, Martial-art etc.

- Career Exposure visits e.g. Police station, Court, Hotel, Hospital, Govt offices etc.
   Celebration of special days like Birthdays, Festivals etc.





#### 5. Shikshadaan – Scholarship for higher education

At PURE India, we encourage students for higher education so we provide scholarships to talented students who have passed class 10<sup>th</sup> but they might not be able to pay for their higher education expenses. Hence we have partnered with **Shikshadaan Foundation** to provide scholarships to our students. In the year 2019-20, we have provided scholarships to 95 students who were bright but came from economically poor families. Following is the summary of 2019-20 scholarships:

#### 6. Career Guidance and Mentoring Program

At PURE India we created awareness about 100 most popular career options among students, parents and teachers and encouraged the students to start thinking about their careers from class 8<sup>th</sup> onwards so that they can decide the right career options at the right time. We conducted many "Student Career Guidance and Awareness Workshops" at Govt. schools of Jaipur, Gurugram, Delhi, Noida, Chennai and Karauli. Following is the summary of this program in the year 2019-20:

#### 7. School Integrated Development Program

Most of the government schools are neglected by local communities and the government officials because the children attending these schools come from low socio-economic backgrounds. We thus decided to adopt a few schools to strengthen infrastructure and education facilities, so that we could increase student enrolment & retention rate, incorporate good teaching and learning techniques and also encourage all the families to send their children to government schools for better education and the future of the children.
