





Skilling & Production: Nirjhari Craft (FPO)

To promote artisans & provide market place, we have stablished a Hub & Spok model, an independent FPO unit (Nirjhari Craft) in the name of 30 rural women artisans in Jaipur. The Nirjhari has various sub-centers in different parts of Rajasthan (Rawatbhata, Bassi, Chomu etc.) from where we procure products and sell through various offline and online platforms e.g. ONDC, Amazon, NirjhariCraft, Etsy etc.

The core objective of this program is to provide market place to various artisans and provide them respectable remuneration of their work. The Unit is producing various products

Scholarships for higher Education

Almost 60% of students get dropped out of school after 10th classes and one of the root cause is their families are not able to afford their higher education expenses. To solve this problem we provide Scholarships for higher studies and for regular skill development courses to marginalized talented students who pass 10th class.

Under this program we also provide Career Guidance & mentoring to the Students so that they can get into a career which they really like.

Primary Beneficiaries: Students who passed 10th class but not completed graduation.

Secondary Beneficiaries: Parents, School & Institutions.

Key outcomes: we have provided Scholarships to 600+ students of higher studies – BTech, MBBS, BCom, BBA, LLB, etc.


Duration: The Scholarship is provided every year based on the quarterly performance report submitted by students.



Mostly govt schools are neglected by local communities and govt officials because the children attending these schools come from low socio-economic backgrounds.

Hence we decided to adopt Govt schools to strengthen infrastructure and education facilities in Govt schools so that we can increase student enrolment & retention rate, incorporate good teaching and learning techniques and also encourage all families to send their children in govt schools for better education.

Our few activities are: Student Career Guidance, Computer Learning, English learning Labs, Sports facilities, School building Coloring & Repair, Roof Water proofing & civil work, Toilet repair & maintenance, Sanitary napkin disposal Incinerators installation, provide Uniform, School Bags, Furniture, Elmira, Ceiling Fan etc based on need.

Saritha (Deaf & Mute) Tailoring Center, Bangalore

Saritha is a Deaf and mute woman however she learnt tailoring skill from her mother and wanted to be self reliant as she get opportunity. She can do all household work very well and make other understand. Her economical condition was not good and was not able to buy a tailoring machine. Her husband is also deaf and dumb. He is a painter and not having regular work. Her mother in law is doing house maid work in other houses. So total income of family is around less than Rs. 8000 monthly. She has a boy of 1 year old. She couldn't work outside due to her disability.

PURE India Team met Saritha during our mobilization and came to know about her family condition. We helped her with new tailoring machine and now she is a earning livelihood on her own and supporting the family. With her work from home job, she is able to take care of her baby and her mother in law did promotion among local residence to get regular business. Now she is very happy and earning Rs 7500 per month.





Krishna Education Center, Karauli, Rajasthan

Krishna Chaturvedi is a 27 year old young positive mind set boy. He lives in a very small village near Karauli district in Rajasthan. He lost his both hands when he was of 6 years old due to an accident in his farms' engine. His both hands stuck in the wheel of the engine and removed completely from the body. After his treatment he studied and did his MA, B Ed education using his legs.

He was job less after the studies however he started providing education classes during covid for the benefits of children but no one paid him fees so he had to stopped teaching after covid so he was really sad as he was of no use. One of the media person inform PURE India Trust's founder about him and immediately was supported to started his Tuition classes again and trust pay him Rs. 100 per student per month now. Now he earn USD 90 per month and also become a coordinator for all other Pathashala centers in Karauli districts.





Padma Tiffin Centre, Hyderabad

Padma is a disabled women with cross legs. She lives in Uppal area and running a small food stall with her husband but they lost their pushcart due to heavy rains last year as it got broken completely. She didn't have enough money to purchase a new one so they lost their daily livelihood also.

During mobilization we met her and she requested for a pushcart so that they can re-start their businesses. PURE India Trust supported her with a pushcart and now she is running food business successfully and earning more than 12000 per month. She is very thankful for the supported provided.



Renuka, Beauty Parlor, Bangalore



Renuka was working in a beauty parlor, while her husband, a driver, was unable to work due to health issues. With an 8-year-old daughter to care for, Renuka struggled to manage all the expenses on her own. The family lived in the beauty parlor shop where she worked, allowed to stay there by the shop owner for a partial rent payment. All the materials in the shop belonged to the owner, leaving Renuka vulnerable; if asked to leave, she would lose her sole source of income. During our mobilization efforts, we learned about her challenging situation.

After conducting a background check, we assisted Renuka in setting up her own beauty parlor with her own materials. She received essential items like a chair and kit materials, which gave her the confidence to manage her expenses independently. Previously reliant on the shop owner's help, Renuka has become self-reliant and now earns 10-12k per month thanks to our support. She has now rented a house and move her family there. Renuka is very happy with the positive change in her life.



Poonam Beauty Parlour, Bilaspur, Gurgaon

I am Poonam, residing in Bilaspur village with my two daughters. Tragically, my husband was killed by some villagers. Despite my expertise in parlor work, I lacked the funds to start my own business. With his absence, managing expenses and providing education for my daughters became arduous.

Attending a meeting at Anganwari, I learned about PURE India Trust's aid for impoverished women. After filling out the form, I received their assistance. Initially immobile due to lack of work, the Trust enabled me to kickstart my parlor business. Now, with my parlor earnings, I effectively manage household expenses, earning 8000+ rupees monthly while staying at home. Grateful for PURE India Trust and Colt Company's support, I am empowered to provide for my family independently.



Saroj Kirana & Gift Centre - Sindhrawali

I am Saroj, residing in Sindhrawali village, and I am differently-abled. Our household faces severe financial hardships, as my husband's income as a laborer is insufficient to support our family of six. Despite my willingness to contribute, my disability prevents me from finding employment. However, through a village meeting, I discovered that PURE India Trust extends support to widows and disabled women. Upon filling out the necessary forms, I received groceries assistance. With this aid, I established my own shop, bringing immense joy and relief. Now, I comfortably manage our household expenses, earning between Rs 10000+ monthly. Thanks to PURE India Trust and Colt Company, my family enjoys a better quality of life. We express our heartfelt gratitude for their unwavering support.



Pushpalatha, Grinding, Bangalore

Pusphalatha, a single parent, worked in housekeeping, earning 2.5k monthly, while her son, employed in a laptop shop, earned 8k. Facing health issues, she couldn't sustain her job, nor could her ailing mother. Struggling with expenses, she aimed to start a grinding business, given the lack of such services nearby. Learning of her plight during mobilization, we aided her in purchasing a grinding machine. Now earning 8-9k monthly, she's self-sufficient, covering both living and medical expenses. Grateful for the support, Pusphalatha finds immense happiness in her newfound independence and stability.



Ayush Ray, IT Branch 2nd year, Global Institute of Technology, Jaipur

My name is Ayush Ray, hailing from a lower middle-class family in Bihar. I excel in my studies, having secured 88% in class 10 and 86% in class 12. Despite our financial constraints, my family managed to enroll me in a reputable engineering college. However, the timely payment of fees poses a significant challenge for my parents, who are daily wage workers. With an annual college fee of approximately Rs. 70,000, the burden was substantial. Thanks to the COLT PURE India Btech Scholarships support, this burden has been significantly alleviated. Now, I can focus on my studies without the constant worry about finances. In my first-semester examinations, I achieved an 8 CGPA, demonstrating my dedication and determination to succeed.
